Brenda Sue Morgan, age 74, passed away peacefully at her home in London, Kentucky on Tuesday, June 13, 2023. She was a graduate of London High School Class of 1966, attended Berea College, received her bachelor's degree from Union College, and proudly earned her master's degree in social work from the University of Kentucky. She moved to the Washington, DC area in the late 1980s and enjoyed a successful career as a licensed clinical social worker. She moved back to London in the early 2000s to be close to her aging parents. Brenda was a former director of Come-Unity Cooperative Care and later retired as social worker for Hospice of the Bluegrass.

She is survived by two daughters, Cindy Wilson and husband Brad of London, Ky, Becky Gilhespie and husband, Rogan, of London, England, and three grandchildren, Savannah Wilson of Bowling Green, Ky, and Oscar and James Gilhespie of London, England.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Oscar and Leona Morgan, and two brothers, Carlos and David Morgan.

A private burial was held at Cumberland Memorial Gardens in Lily, Ky. A celebration of her wonderful life will be held on Saturday, August 5, 2023 at 7:00 p.m. at Creekside Gardens in London, Kentucky. Memorial donations in Brenda's name can be made to the American Parkinson's Disease

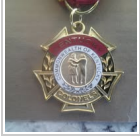
