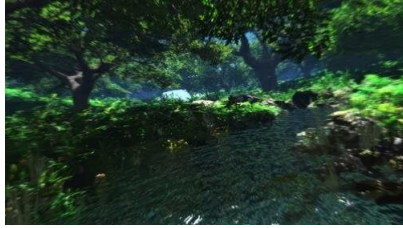
Charles was a self-employed builder for the past ten years. He was a member of Hightop Baptist Church in Keavy, KY.
