Daisy Edna Black, aged 87, of London, Kentucky, passed away peacefully on March 13, 2024, at Morning Pointe of Louisville Senior Living. Born in London, Kentucky, to William and Susan (Hamblin) Wilson, Daisy was the youngest sibling in a large and loving family. Her journey through life was marked by a profound faith in Jesus Christ, her Lord and Savior, which guided her every step and inspired those around her.

Daisy was a beacon of love and devotion, not just to her immediate family but to all who knew her. She married Rothwell (Rocky) Black on October 25, 1958, and together they embarked on a life filled with love, challenges, and achievements. Rocky, her steadfast partner of 65 years, survives her.

before moving back to Kentucky. Her academic achievements were notable, with a graduation from Sue Bennett College in 1957 following her completion of studies at Bush High School in 1955.

Daisy's life was a testament to her deep and abiding faith. She lived her beliefs, embodying the love and grace of Jesus Christ in her daily actions and interactions. Her commitment to her faith was evident in her dedication to prayer and serving others, traits that defined her character.

After making their fortune and raising their family in Illinois, Daisy and Rocky returned to their Kentucky roots in 1986, where they enjoyed their retirement years surrounded by the landscapes and people they loved.

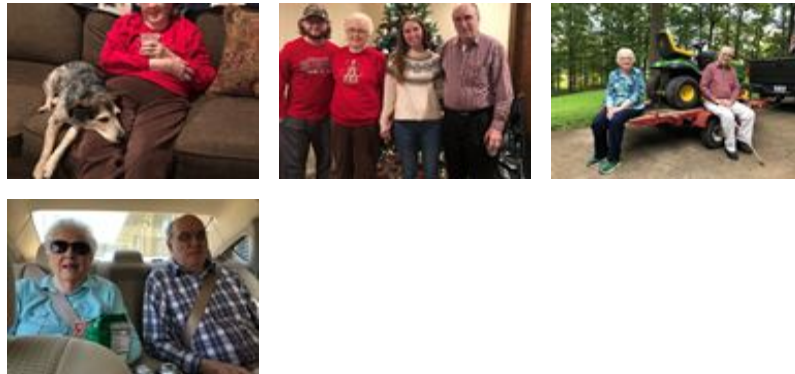

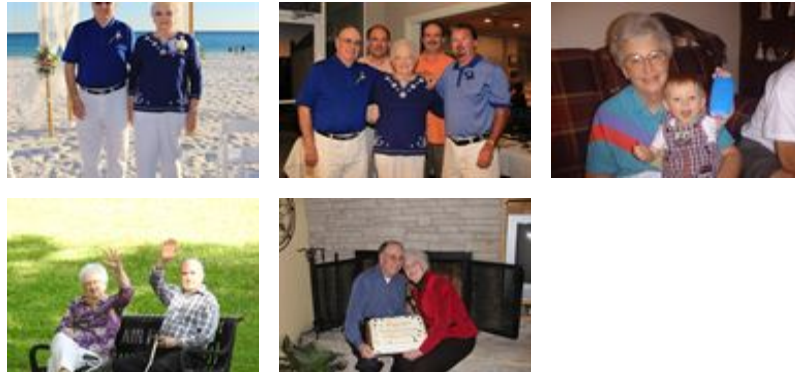
