Dale Brock, 91, of Owensboro, KY, formerly of London, KY, passed away June 2, 2025.

Dale was born in Warbranch, KY, on April 27, 1934, the son of Lige and Mallie Brock.

He proudly served in the U.S. Army during the Korean War and was stationed in Germany for two years. In 1957, Dale married Pauline Simpson, and they moved to Flint, Michigan, where he worked for General Motors for 30 years. Together, they raised three daughters and later retired to London, KY.
