David Glenn Hibbard, age 64 of London, Kentucky passed away on Tuesday, July 27, 2021.

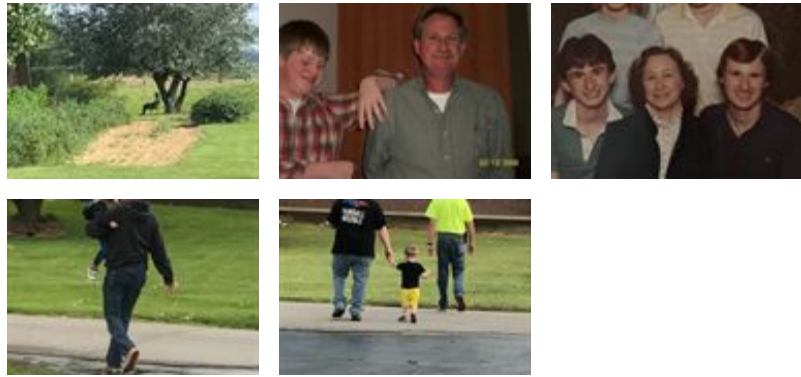

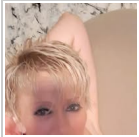

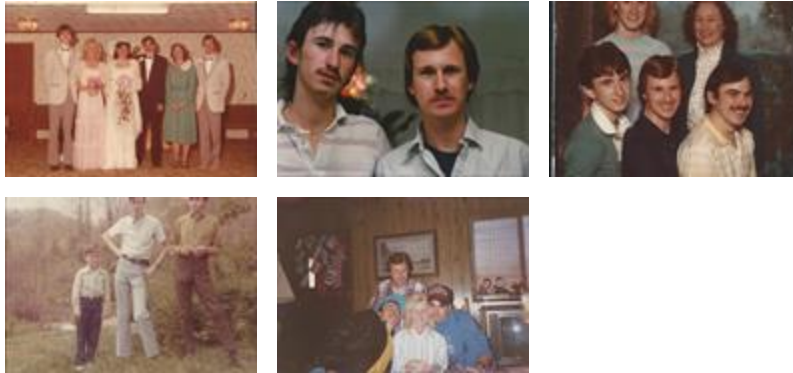
