A man who respected others and earned their respect in return, E.G. lived quietly and honorably. He minded his own business, spoke ill of no one, and treated everyone with fairness and dignity. His character, integrity, and willingness to help made a lasting impression on all who knew him.

More than anything, E.G. loved the people in his life. He was deeply devoted to his family, always caring for them, providing for them, and standing beside them through every season of life. His steady presence, dependable nature, and unconditional love will be greatly missed and forever remembered.

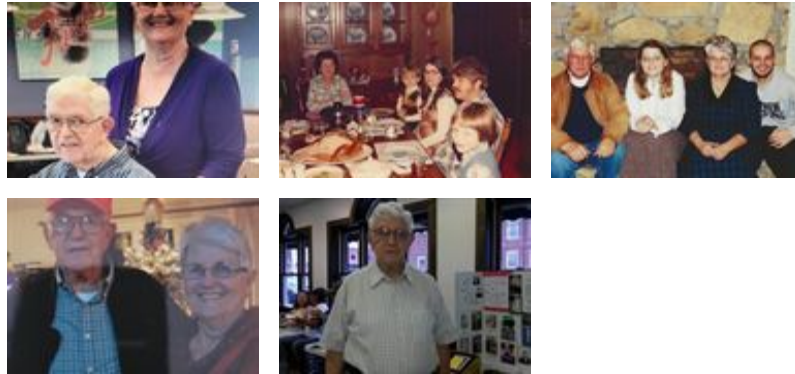
