Fannie Regina Watkins “Gigi”, 91, of London, Kentucky passed peacefully on Saturday, June 11th at Laurel Heights Home for the Elderly, surrounded by loved ones.

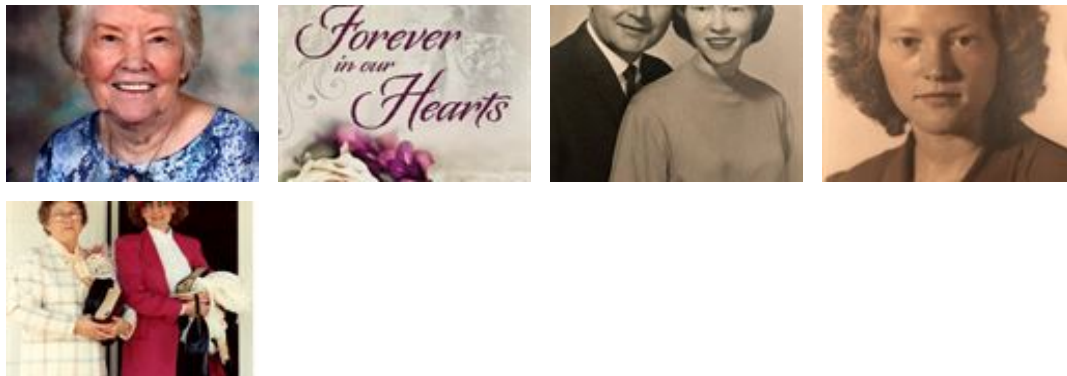
