



## Glenn Aubrey Brock

January 28, 1926 - November 15, 2022

Glenn Aubrey Brock, 96, of Connersville, went home to be with his Lord and Savior Tuesday evening, November 15, 2022. He had been in failing health for the past five years.

He was born January 28, 1926 in Fariston, Laurel County, Kentucky, one of sixteen children of George and Rebecca McFadden Brock.
