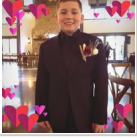

Aunt Ida's prayer was quiet and short and she sat back down at the kitchen table with me watching and listening for good results also. Ma went back to washing and drying those dishes and telling Aunt Ida all the news that happened in London, KY since her last year's vacation from Indianapolis, IN. When Ma sat down at the kitchen table to rest, Aunt Ida asked Ma a serious and important question, "Ma, do you still have a headache?" Ma said, "Why, no, I don't have a headache anymore, Ida." Aunt Ida got really pentecostal happy and maybe a little bit "Hard-Shell Baptist/United Baptist" happy as well. Aunt Ida started praising, shouting and thanking God for healing Ma and removing that painful headache. I smiled and grinned a little, too, not realizing that Jesus would save me as a Baptist boy on May 4, 1963 (12 years & 3 months old), baptize me with the sweet Holy Spirit with pentecostal tongues of firey love, call me to preach, teach, help Him bring healing to the sick and dying plus deliverance from oppressive, addictive demons of sadness, madness, fears, panic attacks, stress, traumatic memories of the past; etc....ALL the honor, glory, praise and thanks goes to Jesus. 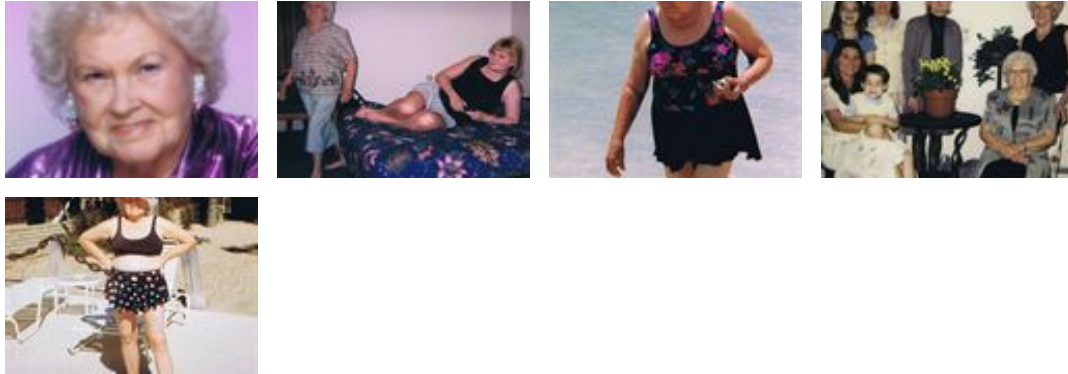

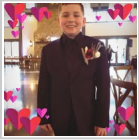
