At London High School he was a star pitcher on the varsity baseball team.

Mike served in the US Air Force 1969-1977 as a Cryptologic Language Analyst achieving the rank of Staff Sergeant.

Having started his college education at ECU, Mike went on to earn a Master of Computer Aided Architecture from the University of Maryland while he was in the Air Force.

Mike's military service locations included Maryland, Texas, Turkey, and Italy.

After leaving the Air Force, Mike returned to London and began a career at Cook Brothers Auto Parts on Main Street.

He married Virginia Contreras in 1971. He and Virginia had a son, Michael.

Mike met and married Pearl Vandy in 1989. They remained married until he passed away on July 17, 2023.
