Judy Weaver Roberts, age 85, of London, Kentucky passed away peacefully on Thursday, January 1, 2026.

Judy was proud of her heritage- proud to be a Weaver. She was quick to tell strangers that it was her family that founded Weavers Restaurant- that it was her mother's recipe that made the chili so famous. 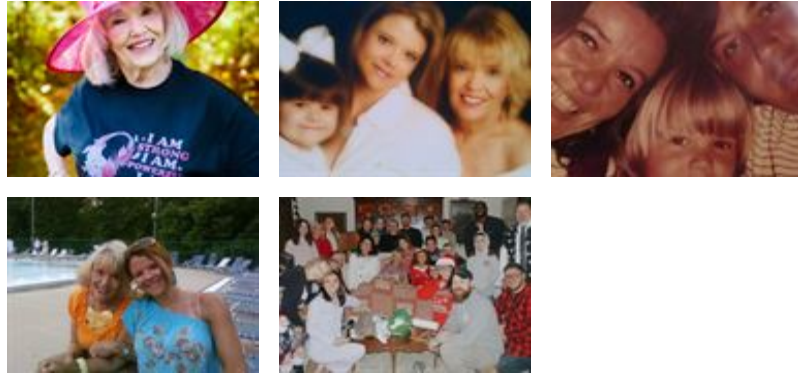
