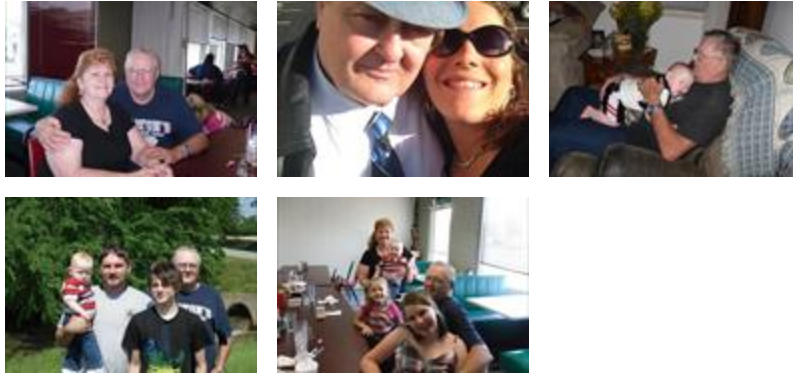

The family has entrusted House-Rawlings Funeral Home with the arrangements.

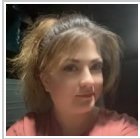

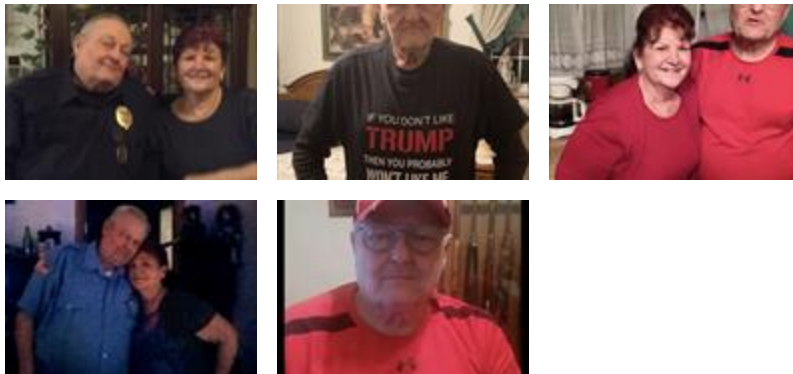
