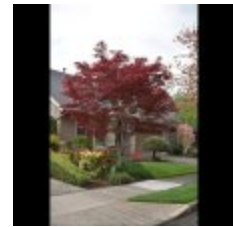

When we were young, Larry and I also walked a long way to school and back over the cold, icy dirt roads of Laurel county. I started in 1948. We did not know Opal’s family when we were young. But we knew Gilmore and Lillian Felts’s family and we knew their parents, Felts and Hodge families. There were just a few families living in Lily and the Slate Ridge areas back then.

My family was living in New Mexico when Opal and Larry Wayne married. She was very pretty and he was really smitten with her. I am very grateful to Opal for taking care of Larry all these years. Could not have been easy!
I am also grateful to Larry and Opal for the help they extended to my mother in her late years.

When we visited from New Mexico, Larry always let my boys drive the tractors and Opal always had a wonderful breakfast of biscuits, gravy and eggs. They came to New Mexico several times at Christmas when the boys were young and would take them sledding in the mountains. They always came to the boy’s graduation ceremonies from high school and college—even to Colorado and Oregon! I remember when we went to the Pacific Ocean in Oregon, Opal was really pleased. It was the first time she had seen the ocean and then we also went on a ferry ride to the islands in Washington afterwards. They had a really good time visiting with the boys! They remember her as a kind, loving lady and a fantastic cook!

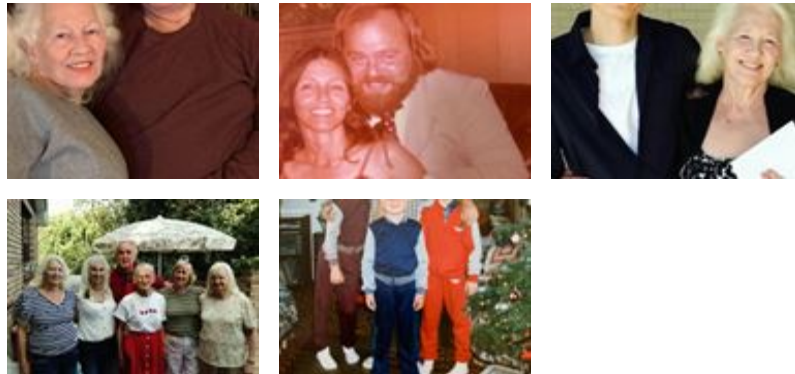

“ I am Opal's little brother, Denver. I am 73 now. I started school with Opal at Slate Ridge. We walked 2 miles each way to this little one room school with a pot belly coal fired stove. I was in the first row in first grade. All grades 1-8 were in this same room. Opal was in 6th grade and always looked out after me. We all had our tin cups for a water bucket filled from a spring out back. Gilmore Felts was our teacher. We ate lunch on a fallen tree behind the school. We were poor and usually had homemade biscuits and jelly for lunch. Winters were cold walking because we didn't always have a heavy coat. My memories like this will be in my heart until I see Opal again. She was always my loving sister. I loved her even though we argued and fought as siblings. I kinda grew up with her since my other sisters were older and had left home. She was the BEST!
