I am writing to express my deepest condolences for the loss of Mr. Houston. I know this must be an incredibly difficult time for you all.

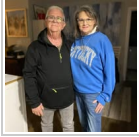

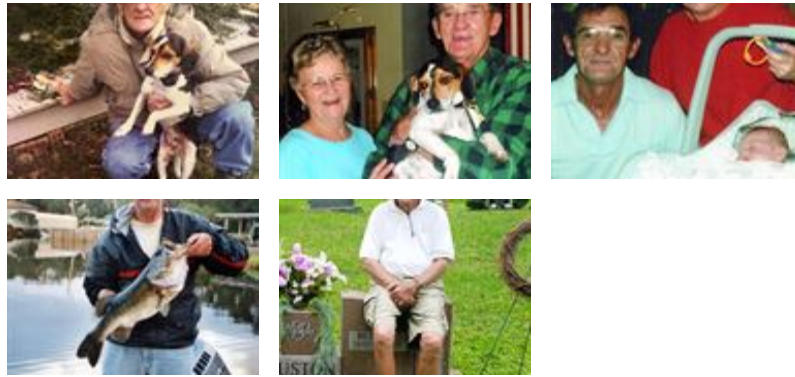
