Phoebe Diane Bowman Comstock died May 17. She was born June 30, 1939, in East Bernstadt, Kentucky, to James Russell Bowman and Ruth “Jim” Vinson Bowman. Diane graduated from Arsenal Technical High School and earned her B.A. and M.A. from Butler University. An English teacher at Tech for thirty-three years, she served as department head for seven years, and was honored as ICTE Hoosier Teacher of the Year (1983) and Distinguished Tech Alumna. Diane earned the Hanson H. Anderson Service Award and was Past Scholarship Task Force Chairman, Indianapolis Urban League and Service Representative of Indianapolis Chapter of Phi Delta Kappa. A prolific letter writer, she wrote for several educational publications and was former editor of her community newsletter.
