He was the first African American to integrate London High School and also Sue Bennett College. He received his bachelor's degree from Kentucky State University and achieved 40 hours above his master's degree. He worked for the Detroit Public Schools System for 30 years as a teacher, department head and Dean of Students. He always stated that his greatest accomplishment was being the number one salesperson for AFLAC Insurance Co. in Southeastern Michigan. He also served for 2 years in the U.S. Army. He was also incredibly happy with the success that he achieved in life.
