Raymond C. Roark, age 73 of London, passed away on Thursday, March 26 at his residence. He was born August 22, 1941 in Roark, KY to the late Charlie & Siller Shepherd Roark of London, KY. He was a captain of the Laurel County Sherriff Department, a veteran of the US Army, former chief of the East Bernstadt Fire Department and affiliated with the Baptist faith.
