Shannon J. Grant Caldwell, age 47, of Somerset, Kentucky passed away on Friday, June 9, 2023.

He leaves behind his loving wife, Paula Hester Caldwell; three siblings, Rodney Caldwell and wife Melissa, Shawna Sanders, Frankie Wayne Simpson; several nieces, nephews, great nieces and great nephews; plus a host of other family and friends to mourn his passing.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Grant and Ruth Collett Caldwell; and by his brother, Jamie Caldwell.

Shannon obtained his Bachelor's degree in social work and minored in sociology. He was an advocate for people with disabilities, served on multiple counsels, and was an ambassador for Alstrom Syndrome. He figured out technology for the blind and made a difference for people with disabilities. Shannon was a kind and Godly man who loved his family very much. He was a strong and faithful Christian and knew the Bible very well. He had multiple gifts, and was a gifted preacher. He was also very humorous, loved to joke around and bring joy to others.

Funeral services for Shannon J. Grant Caldwell will be held on Monday, June 12, 2023 beginning at 1:00 p.m. in the chapel of House-Rawlings Funeral

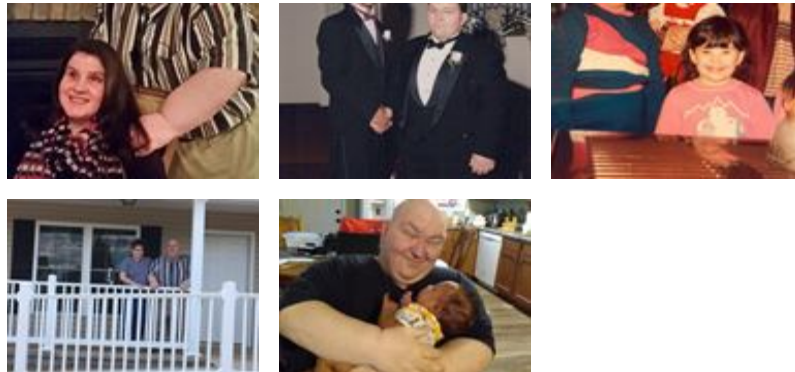

“ Dear Alstrom Family,

By now, most of you are aware that we recently lost Shannon Caldwell. Those of you who knew and loved Shannon as Jan and I did, have done a beautiful job of testifying to the essential qualities of this magnificent gentle(man). His generosity of spirit, his kindness, his intelligence, his incomparable wit, his wisdom and his genuine humility were palpable in every encounter. He never failed in putting others before himself. I admired him, respected him, valued his advice, and leaned on him. Shortly after I lost Jan, I did what she would have wanted, and we went forward with a planned A-Team Retreat here on Mount Desert Island in Maine, close by our home. Thirteen A-Teamers were here with me with Shannon (and Paula), their acknowledged leader(s), for Jan's Remembrance. Shannon took me aside before the service, prayed with me, held me, and told me how lucky all the Alstrom Angels were to have Jan with them...."while you're stuck down here with this motley crew." I laughed and made it through the day. I've been a lucky man to have known and loved Jan, to have known and loved (and lost) so many in Alstrom Land, and to continue to find richness and meaning and yet more love in our new generations. Though Paula does not have Alstrom Syndrome, she has been blind since birth. Few marriages are as flawlessly executed as theirs. I remember, in 2010 at the International Conference in Helen, Georgia, when Shannon, on a decade or longer anniversary, decided to re-propose. No warning! When he dropped to a knee, I very nearly called 911! The cheers resounded and all was well.

Today, I am writing to ask that you join me in supporting Paula as she seeks to provide Shannon with the funeral that Shannon wished for. He told her to get it done quickly, and the arrangements have been made for THIS Monday. Remarkably strong woman! These Caldwell's were poor but never lacking, humble but always dignified, generous in all ways available to them, and always reluctant to ask, so, I, who have had the high privilege of knowing and loving them, am asking on their behalf that you help see Shannon out.

Any donations in excess of the actual cost of \$9,500 for expenses will be remitted to Paula and help redress her straightened financial
