



## Silas W. "Si" Brock Jr.

Silas W. "Si" Brock Jr., age 85 of London, passed away on Sunday, October 26 at Baptist One-Health in Lexington. He is survived by his two sons: Roger G. Brock of Hammond, IN and Randy N. Brock of London, KY. He was preceded in death by his wife of 48 years, Sheila Jane Brock. He was born in Bush, KY the son of late Silas W. Brock Sr. and the late Mary Jane Gilbert Brock. He was an attendee of Bush School, a US Navy veteran from 1946-47 and a member of Calvary Baptist Church in London, KY. He resided in Hammond, IN for 50 years and worked at LTV Steel in East Chicago, IN for 40 years.
