Sue Emma Lovelace Taylor, 89, passed away Sunday morning, March 6, at the Heritage SNF, Corbin, as her caregivers sang hymns to her. She is predeceased by her husband of 53 years Harold L. Taylor, her parents G.T. "Tip" and Esther Lovelace, and brother Gordon Lovelace.
