Tilman Taylor, age 86, of London, Kentucky passed away on Friday, July 31, 2020.

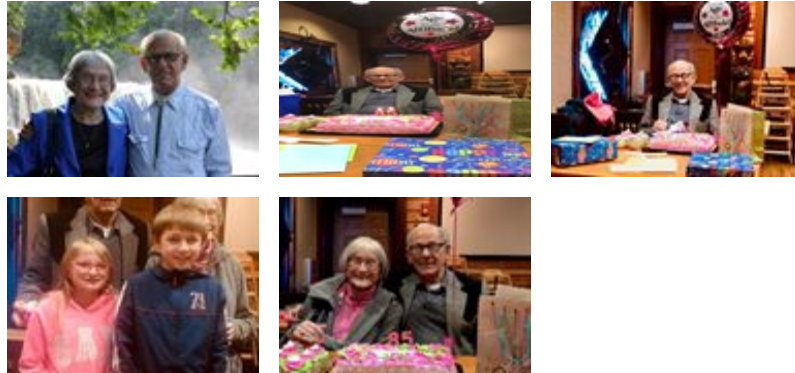

I keep having to stop writing, because of the crying.. I was lucky enough to be included in your family from when I stayed with you in 92/93. At 17 years old, I came to spend a year with an American family, that I didn't know - far away from my home in Northern Norway.

From the first moment I met you and Flora at the airport, I felt nothing but love.

You took me in, and treated me like a daughter from that moment on.

I couldn't hardly understand what you were saying the first couple of weeks, but it worked itself out :)

Even if we didn't have the deep conversations, I knew I could always rely on you. You would defend me fiercely if needed, and would tell people I was your Norwegian daughter. You were so proud of me.

I've been back to visit several times, but it's been twelve years since I last saw you. Me and my family visited in 2008, and you loved holding the twins - who were almost a year at the time.

I am so sorry I didn't get to hug you and talk to you before you passed. I didn't get to tell you I'm alright - everything worked out. I didn't get to tell you how much I respected and loved you. I hope you know, wherever you are. And I hope to see you again in the afterlife.

As we say in Norway, when a loved one passes, and words really can't cover how we feel; «Takk for alt» - Thank you for everything.
