Throughout the years she sang many songs, most being remembered her solo "I Know the Master of the Wind" and The Hensley's most popular song "Magnificent Jesus" written by her cousin C.A. Williams.

Renaee will be greatly missed but forever remembered for her faith, her servant's heart, and the love she gave so freely to everyone around her.

Vicky Renaee departed this life on Monday March 9, 2026, leaving her at the age 66 years 10 months and 13 days of age.
